- Special Monthly Events!**

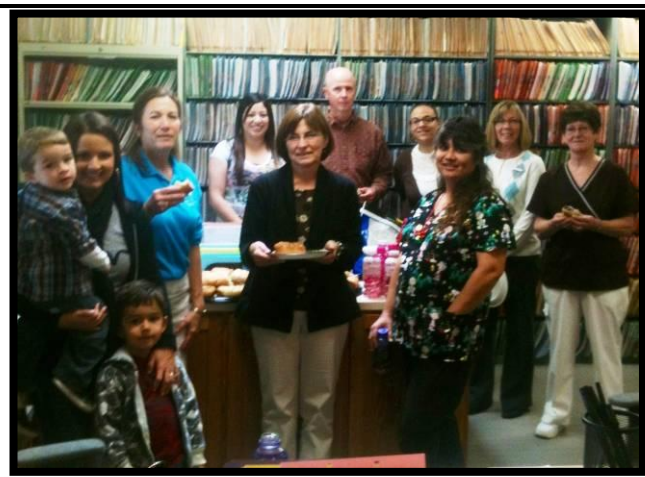
