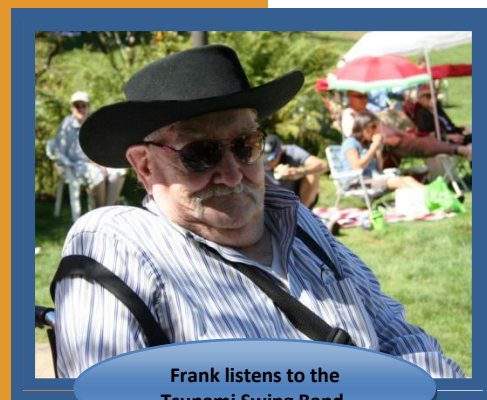


## Every Trip is an Adventure

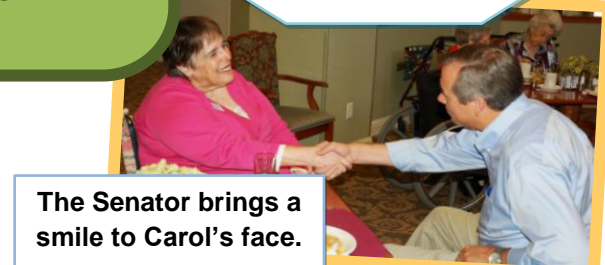

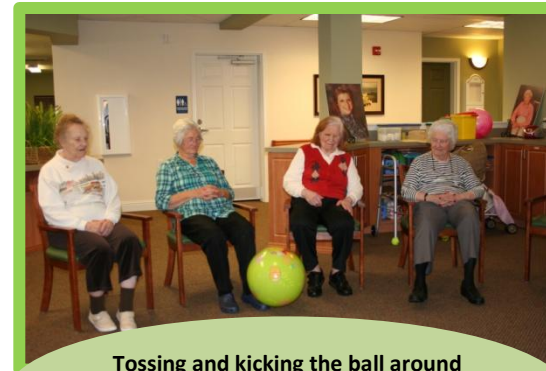
